József Balogh is a clarinetist, composer, and teacher with more than 30 years of experience in orchestral, solo, chamber music, educational, and organizational work. He is actively involved in both the Hungarian and international music scene through concerts, recordings, teaching, and participation in various musical organizations. In addition to classical music, he is also an excellent performer and connoisseur of many other musical styles – including jazz, klezmer, and world music.

Education

- József Balogh began his musical studies at the age of 9 in Pécs, where he also completed his conservatory education.
- In 1979, he graduated from the Liszt Ferenc Academy of Music as a student of Béla Kovács. Between 1988 and 1992, he was a teacher at the Academy.
- Since 1976, he has been the principal clarinetist of the Hungarian State Opera.
- Since 1985, he has served as principal clarinetist of the Hungarian Radio Symphony Orchestra.
- In 1989, he won the Solti György Scholarship and joined the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, where he studied with Larry Combs, the orchestra's principal clarinetist.


