- He began his musical education at the age of five at the Józsefváros Music School, where he studied cello under Katalin Keller-Gergelyné.
- At the age of 13, he performed on the same stage at the Mozarteum in Salzburg alongside world-renowned cellist Mischa Maisky and pianist Martha Argerich.
- At 14, he was admitted to the Bartók Béla Secondary School of Music, studying under István Varga.

- He has participated four times in the "Musical Hungary" program and in the "Musical Budapest" festival.
- In 2019, he was a finalist in the classical music competition *Chamber Virtuosos* on Duna TV. Following this, he performed at the Bartók Festival with the Miskolc Symphony Orchestra under the baton of Gergely Kesselyák.
- That same year, he performed at the *Zenergia* concert organized by MVM Zrt., held at the square in front of St. Stephen's Basilica.
- Also in 2019, he was invited to play at the Sándor Palace at the request of Mrs. Anita Herczegh, as a participant in the *Virtuosos* classical music competition.
- In January 2020, he took part in the New Year's concert hosted by the Office of the President of the Republic, performing with the orchestra of his brother, Lajos Sárközi—Liszt Prize, Junior Prima Prize, and Cziffra Talent Prize-winning violinist.
- That same month, he gave a concert at the Vigadó for the New Year's event of the Ministry of Agriculture.
- Rudolf is the double bassist of *Gipsy Virtuosos*, a group founded by Zoltán Mága. He regularly participates in charity concerts alongside the Liszt and Meritorious Artist Prize-winning violinist
- He successfully completed three full runs of the 100 Church Charity Concert Series, performing in support of Ukrainian refugee families, underprivileged and gifted children, and youth living in foster care.
- For the past six years, he has taught disadvantaged Roma children in Heves County and is a member of the Rural Rajkó Orchestra, which supports underprivileged schoolchildren. His mission is to preserve and promote the fading tradition of Hungarian-Romani café music and Hungarian cultural heritage worldwide.
