- From 1977 to 1988, he performed as a featured show vocalist in the Angham Al-Shabab Show Orchestra, part of the Popular and Performing Arts Sector, contributing to performances both within and outside Egypt.
- He has taken part in many international competitions and festivals (France, Turkey, Germany, Greece, Italy, and Morocco).
- Presently, he holds a lecturing position at the Conservatoire de France College of Music in the Vocal Department.
