Education

- Frankie Látó began his classical music studies in 1975 under the guidance of his first violin teacher, Béla Stanics.
- In 1985, he was admitted to the Violin Department of the Szeged Conservatory.
- In 1989, he enrolled at the Conservatoire and College of Boulogne, where he studied until 1992.
- For five years, he was a student of one of France's greatest violinists, Didier Lockwood.
- In addition to his classical training, he also mastered traditional Hungarian and Transylvanian violin techniques.

Discography

- He has released three solo albums to date.
- Additionally, he has been featured as a guest artist on seven other records.

Composer Work

- In 2003, he composed the music for August Strindberg's play Crimes and Crimes, which was staged at the Új Színház (New Theatre) in Budapest, directed by Péter Rudolf.
